Accidental Death & Dismemberment Insurance

This 24/7, \$10,000 accidental death and dismemberment group policy covers any loss resulting from a bodily injury to an MCVFA member. The AD&D policy amounts double for line-of-duty incidents.

Scholarships

The Robert J. Hindley Memorial Scholarship is awarded yearly to a deserving candidate who fit the program's criteria to pursue higher education.
